A Shelter Box helps a family of 10 survive for six months. It contains a large tent, blankets, water purification tablets, cooking equipment, basic tools and a multi-fuel stove. *Rotary International has already shipped about 2000 Shelter Boxes with 1700 to be delivered on Friday, Jan 29th.*

Last week Powhatan School donated \$1000 for a Shelter Box. With this donation, we could provide a total of 4 Shelter Boxes - if we can collect an additional \$800. Please place your donations in the basket on your table....checks should be made out to Winchester Rotary - Shelter Box program.



### Rotarians Against Hunger

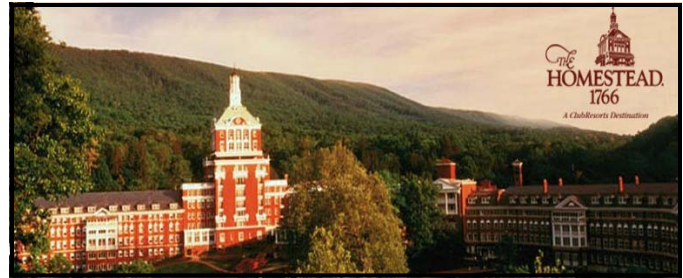
