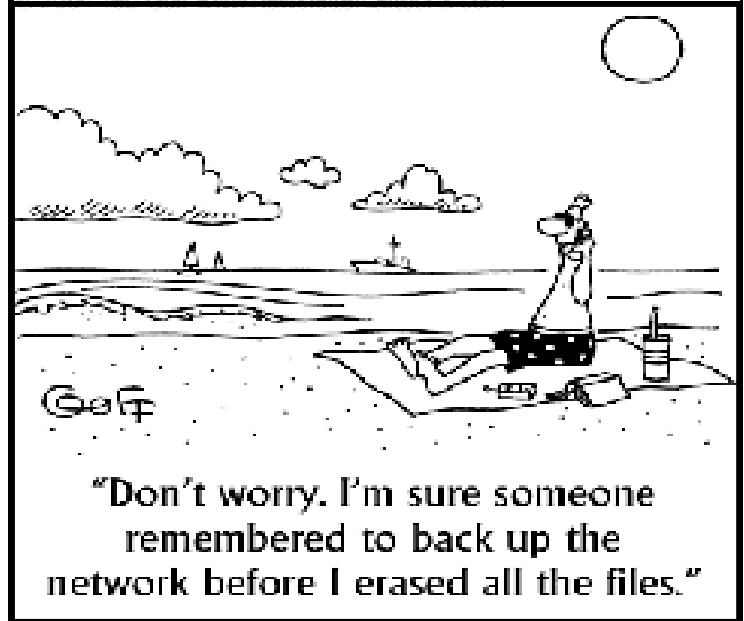


5K Run for Polio
