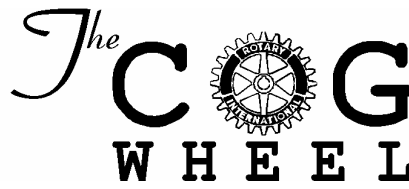

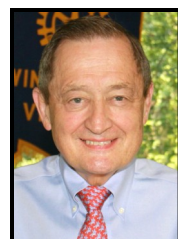
Last Week - More New Member Talks
