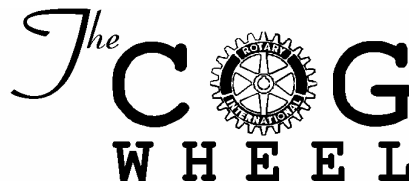

Our Family picnic was last week ... and a good time was had by all!

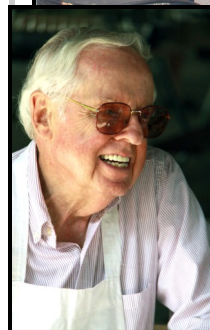

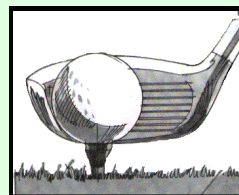
