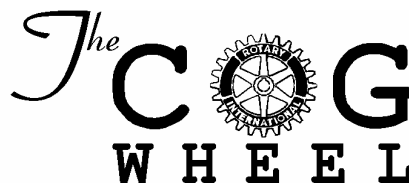

Our Program Last Week

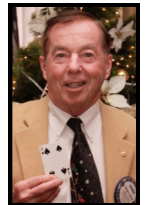
