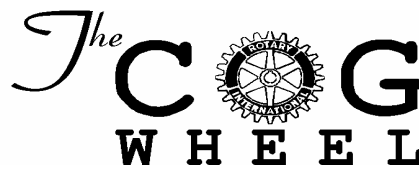

Our own Chris Northrup described his passion for the High-Five Sports Camp that emphasizes sportsmanship teambuilding, and life coping skills to youth. The youth invited to the camp are between 9-11 years of age and from our local surrounding schools. This annual project that he initiated and continues to run, offering a unique opportunity for children who may not have the ability to attend a camp through other means. The camp is held three times during the year, two summer sessions, and one weekly session is held during a school break.

The theme around the camp curriculum uses sports and outdoor activities to promote skills that the youth can use when dealing with difficult situations, learning to become team players, and work with others. The camp also provides an excellent opportunity for the youth to get some physical exercise and relieve stress and most of all, to have FUN!

Glenn Burdick drew the 5 of clubs last week, so the pot continues to grow. Glenn received \$21.00 and our new jackpot is at \$350!

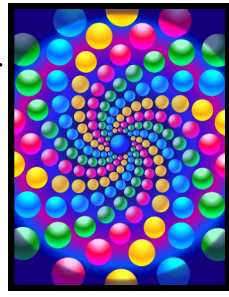


**ROTARY SUPPORTS OUR TROOPS**
