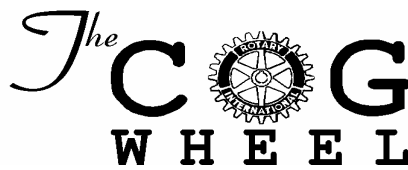

Last Week's Program - 2 for the price of 1

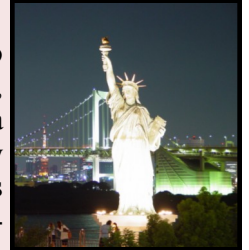
