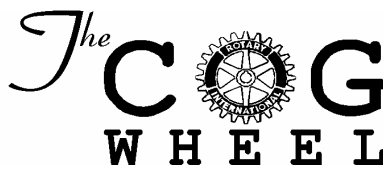

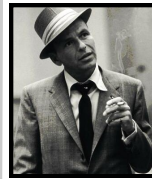
Last week's program

Last week, Eric Meyer, D.V.M.(ret.) described **Heifer International**, a charitable organization that works with communities to end hunger and poverty and care for the earth. By giving families a hand-up, not just a hand-out, they empower them to turn lives of hunger and poverty into self-reliance and hope. With gifts of livestock and training, they help families improve their nutrition and generate income in sustainable ways. They refer to the animals as "living loans" because in exchange for their livestock and training, families agree to give one of its animal's offspring to another family in need. It's called *Passing on the Gift* – a cornerstone of their mission. Dr. Meyer also shared highlights of his mission "scholar" trip with photographs of donated equipment, grateful recipients, and... a mound.

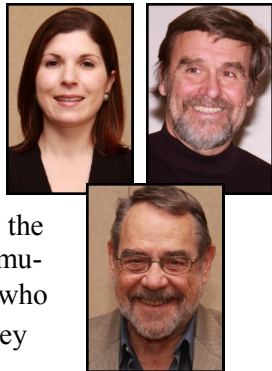
We Need More Rummage!

(just in time for the Festival)

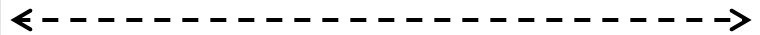
