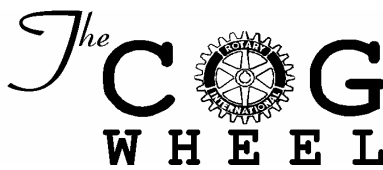

**Foundation Minute**

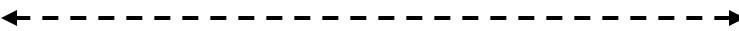
Irv Shendow discussed one of six areas for global grants - literacy and access to basic education. He discussed how the grants support increasing adult literacy and eliminating gender bias.
