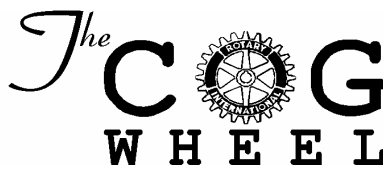

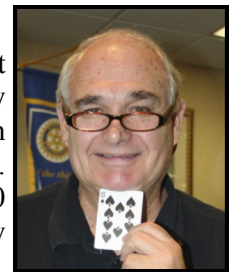
Our Last Program

We were treated to a wonderful presentation by Carolina Barros Lopes, a Rotary Exchange student from Itatinga, Brazil – or as it is correctly spelled in Portuguese, Brasil. Carolina was introduced by her host father, Bill Pence of the Woodstock Rotary Club. She has been in the US for nine months and is at the end of her term. She gave a wonderful presentation on Brazil, a country known for its beautiful beaches, soccer, and its carnivals. The country is home to 190 million people, 80% of them Catholic. In 2014 they will host the Soccer World Cup and attempt to win their 6th trophy. In 2016 they will host the Summer Olympics. One of the 7 Wonders of the World is the 130 ft. tall Christ the Redeemer statue. Carolina is from a small community of 17,000 people with much similarity to the Shenandoah Valley. Two of her most exciting firsts since coming to the states are seeing snow and squirrels. She ended her presentation with a beautiful quotation that describes her year... "Why do you leave? So that you can come back and see with new eyes". She knows that this experience has changed her forever and when she returns to Brazil, she will see what she left with new eyes, ever grateful to Rotary for this life-changing opportunity.
