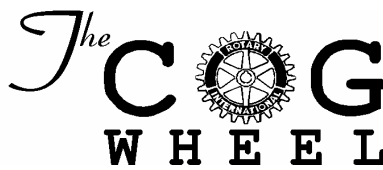

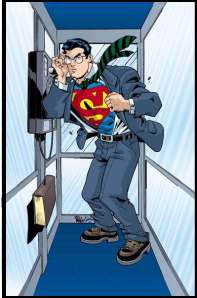

**Foundation Moment**

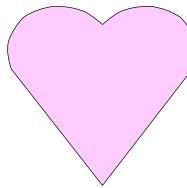
**"CHARGE IT" for Rotary!**
