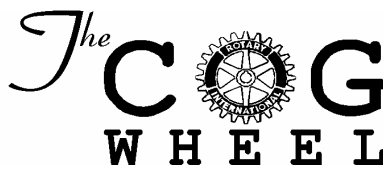

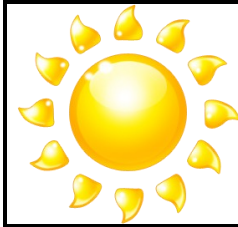

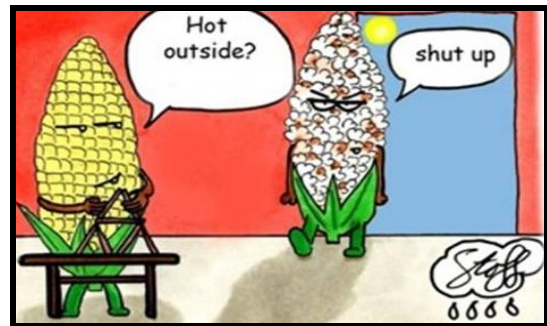
Visitors & Guests July 21st
