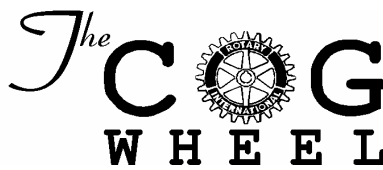

The program helps those dealing with serious illness by providing online information, resources and exchanges, and an anonymous virtual support group. Clients are allowed to journal about their disease progress 24-7 at [treatmentdiaries.com](http://treatmentdiaries.com). This has proven to be instrumental in the recovery process – studies have shown journaling is a way to promote wellness.
