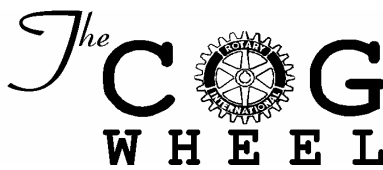

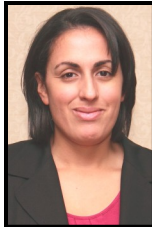

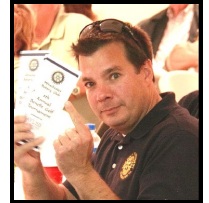
### Rotary Supports Our Troops

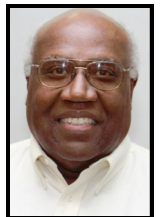
