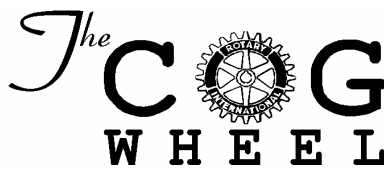

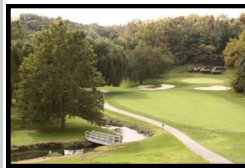
#### Last Week's Program

#### The Second Time Around's the Charm

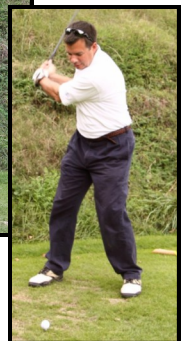
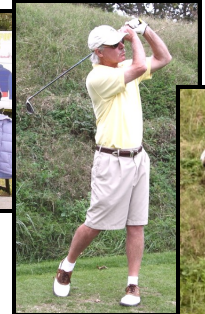
Hats off to Don Louque, III, Erik Beatley and Crew for running a fantastic golf tournament last Monday.
