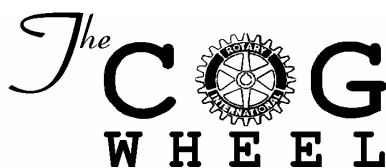

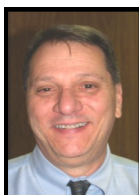

FLAG DAY!

On June 14, 1777, in order to establish an official flag for the new nation, the Continental Congress passed the **first Flag Act**: "*Resolved, That the flag of the United States be made of thirteen stripes, alternate red and white; that the union be thirteen stars, white in a blue field, representing a new Constellation.*"

May 30th, 1916 after three decades of state and local celebrations, President Woodrow Wilson officially *established* June 14th as FLAG DAY - the anniversary of the Flag Resolution of 1777. August 3rd, 1949, President Truman signed an Act of Congress designating June 14th of each year as **National Flag Day**.
