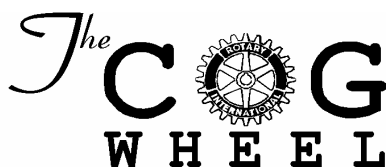

Last week's Program:

Richard Bell spoke to us about the objectives and accomplishments of Preservation of Historic Winchester. PHW was a response to the urban renewal of the 1960's, when numerous historic properties were demolished to make way for new construction.

PHW's current top priority is the Taylor Hotel, in downtown Winchester. The original proprietor, Bushrod Taylor, was a transportation titan who developed roads to Winchester, resulting in the town becoming a trade center. If the Taylor Hotel were demolished, it could be 20 years before anything new is built to fill that space downtown.

In the past year, key accomplishments of PHW included work on 144-146 North Loudoun (aka the Blind Faith building), renovation of the Simon Lauck House at 311 South Loudoun where a log structure was found inside a newer surrounding building, renovation of the Toll House at 800 Amherst, and the nearly completed Solenberger building at 142 North Loudoun. Upcoming projects include the Darlington Hotel and the old City Jail. And here's a health tip for your house, Richard Bell says vinyl siding and painted brick trap moisture which will cause rot.
