Miles and miles of new sidewalks...at a cost of millions and a timeframe of 10 months, the project has now expanded to Amherst Street - 50 West (who could miss that work).

Downtown mall—it's a project three years in the planning, it will be completed over a 4-month cycle beginning at year-end and costing \$7M. The project will include new water and sewer, streets, and entranceways on the north and south ends. The water fountain that our club donated will be moved from in front of the Old Courthouse to the greens of the Our Health campus. There will also be a new self cleaning public restroom with all kinds of bells and whistles.

Other projects recently completed and/or in process include the Green Circle and LED lighting in area streetlights.
