### Today's Program - Jason Wright Talks Christmas Jars

Back by popular demand. Jason Wright, NY Times Best Selling Author returns to the Rotary Club to discuss his book Christmas Jars. The Holiday Season is about giving. Learn about this unique way to give to your fellow man.

### Our Last Program

Trevor Patzer, co-founder and executive director of the **Little Sisters Fund**, spoke about his non-profit organization, which is dedicated to educating poor and at-risk girls in Nepal.



Forty percent of girls there, 14 and younger are married and half of all girls become pregnant by the age of 16. Young girls are subjected to back-breaking labor in the fields, and live in danger of being sold or abducted into the sex trade. The best way to break this cycle is to provide young girls with an education. The Little Sisters Fund plays a crucial role, because poor families believe that sending daughters to school will pay no immediate return on investment.

The Little Sisters Fund is currently providing scholarships for 1150 girls to attend school for 8 to 10 years. They are seeing a high rate of success, with 100% of all scholarship recipients graduating from high school. Educated girls are less likely to become pregnant as teenagers, and less likely to experience domestic abuse. For 2013, the Little Sisters Fund plans to add 100 more girls, and to launch a teacher training program.
