Last weeks guest speaker Martina Frycova hails from the Czech Republic, is a past President of Roteract and has been a member since 2007. She is on a 23 stopspeaking tour called the "*Rails and Water Tour*". The tour's purpose is to promote Rotary International's work to clean water, build schools and help mothers and children live healthy lives through better sanitation practices. The tour not only educates the public about Rotary work, but also acts as a fundraising tool. Much of this money is targeted for use in Afghanistan in building and rebuilding septic tanks, schools and clinics. As a part of the ongoing plan these facilities are being built in clusters, this allows users to easily access resources and promotes family use. The schools are sometimes unique to the region as they also provide schools for girls.

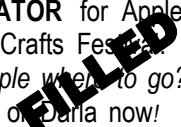
