### Last Week's Program

The historical novelist Bob O'Conner spoke to us about his latest book entitled ***A House Divided.*** Like all of his novels he uses real events, real people and then fills in a dialogue for his story. This book recounts the story of 4 people including 2 brothers who fight on opposing sides during the Civil War. In reality the oft used phrase of "brother against brother" was unusual. However, in the case of these two brothers, they did fight against each other twice although not face to face. They fought first at the Battle of Kernstown and then Stephenson Depot aka 2<sup>nd</sup> Winchester. The Yankee brother Jack, was in fact, shot in battle and medically treated by CSA medical staff at the insistence of his Confederate brother, Wesley. This fascinating novel was all written on the basis of 17 letters and military records. Other books by the author include: ***Countdown to West Virginia Statehood, Return of Catesby and The Life of Abraham Lincoln as President.***
