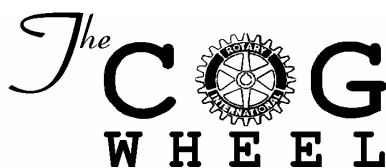

Our Last Program

Mark Jordan, from the Front Royal Rotary Club, spoke about the Rotary Foundation. One of the great strengths of the Rotary Foundation, is the combined power of people from around the world, working together. A few of the ways the Foundation achieves its mission is through Matching Grants, Group Study Exchange Teams, and Ambassadorial Teams. Projects to provide clean water in remote areas have nearly eliminated the Guinea worm. Another important success has been the near eradication of Polio.

Funds for Foundation activities are distributed worldwide through the *SHARE* system. The money contributed by a district is invested for three years. The investment earnings pay operating costs for the Rotary Foundation. After three years, one half of the funds are sent back to the Rotary District and half go to the World Fund.

You can help as a Sustainer by pledging \$100 per year, becoming a Paul Harris Fellow through a gift of \$1000, or a Benefactor by bequeathing at least \$1000 to the Rotary Foundation.
