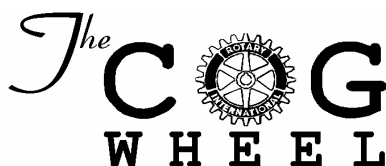

It's at the Museum of The Shenandoah Valley tomorrow evening. Get your tickets from Tootie Rinker, Dick Kent, or Darla McCrary.

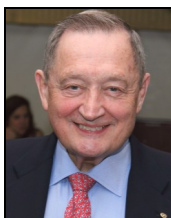

PROJECT COORDINATOR**

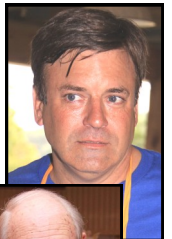
