"Seeing how these people survive, you cannot not be affected." That pretty much summed up Conrad Koneczny's program as he shared photos and memories of his recent trip to the Caribbean to deliver wheelchairs to people who desperately needed them. His



whirlwind tour included the islands of Trinidad (which was their home base), Guyana, Antigua, and Saint Lucia.

Conrad's group delivered 1500 wheelchairs, of which about 110 were hand-delivered in person. Conrad's moving stories included children who previously had to be piggy-backed everywhere they went and a woman who had previously spent her life lying on a blanket, which took four people to move. Her new wheelchair made it possible for the first time for one person to transport her.

Conrad's lasting impressions included the harsh conditions facing the people he met, their hospitality, and the abundant food (and beer) that was provided.
