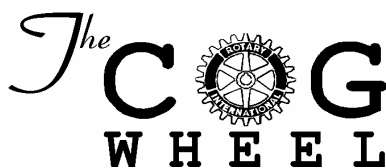

Last Week's Program

Cheryl Thompson-Stacy and Al Toxopeus shared information about Lord Fairfax Community College and the Virginia Community College system. There are 23 colleges in the system, with 40 separate campuses. These colleges educate more than 400,000 students, representing two out of three undergraduate students in the state. Our presenters reviewed the history of the system, starting with its inception in 1955 when a committee was developed to examine the prospect of establishing community colleges in the state. Community colleges provide the benefit of career-sustaining education to these students at a fraction of the cost associated with attending a four-year university.



Our very own LFCC was recognized as the fastest growing college for 2011-2012, and it has been in the top three fastest growing colleges for the past five years. The school has garnered a wide range of awards for its academics, its reputation as a veteran-friendly school, and its use of technology in the classroom.

Our very own Al was recently honored by LFCC when the college named their Welcome Center after him in tribute to his years of support for the community college system. At last week's meeting, the Winchester Rotary club proudly donated \$2,500 to the LFCC Foundation in his name.

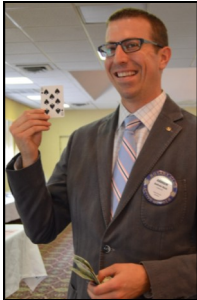

Libba's Health Tip of the Week

Stroke is the fourth leading cause of death in the United States. If you believe a loved one may be having a stroke, first ask them to smile to check for noticeable facial "lagging" on one side or the other. Second, have them raise their arms and check to make sure they can hold both arms in an elevated position without difficulty. Finally, ask them to say a simple sentence to check for any slurring. If they fail any one of these tests, Libba says you should call 911 immediately. Remember: "Time lost is brain lost."
