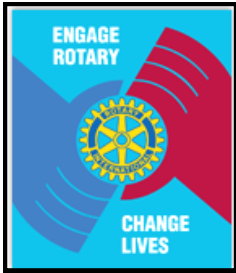
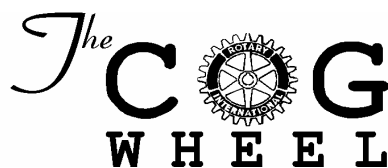

Let's face it...to mosquitos, some of us look like a Pot Luck Supper at the local Methodist Church. In fact, 20% of us are prone to mosquito bites-those with blood Type O, those who are larger (tall and wide variety), and those who are pregnant. And, if you drink beer, mosquitos really like that too. Besides using a good bug repellent, you can wear light-colored, loose clothes and avoid using scented products when outdoors, especially at peak feeding hours-dusk to dawn for most mosquitos. Consumer Reports rated Off Deep Woods Sportsmen II as the most effective at repelling the little buggers!
