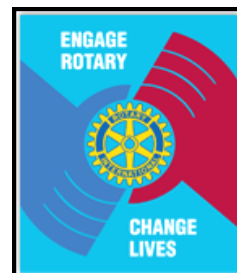

Rich Reedy has been in the hospital but we do not have location or contact information. If any member has contact information for his son Michael, please share that with Libba so that we can check how Rich is doing.

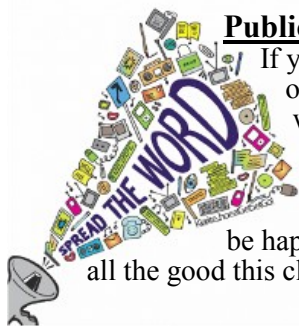
