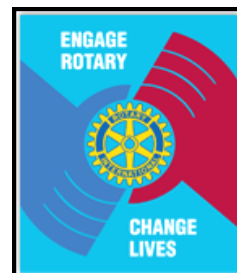

### Last Week

Rachael Cine of Project Hope spoke to us about the history and mission of Project Hope which was established in 1958 by WW II veteran Dr. Welsh with just one donated ship and \$150. PH operates as an International NGO (*non-governmental organization*) serving the entire world with a mission of medical hope to the desperate and needy.

The USS Hope was the highly recognized ship that served as a floating hospital ship for Project Hope but it was retired in 1974 when the group became land based. Their mission is to treat chronic diseases, team with pharmaceutical companies to provide medicine to the poorest people of the world, teach healthcare practices, provide healthcare to orphans and other vulnerable children. Project Hope also responds to natural disasters such as hurricanes, earthquakes and floods.

In 2004 Project Hope returned to the seas when it began operating from the USS Mercy. Currently Project hope is working in over 30 countries in every region of the world. They also assist the US Navy each year with a 3 week sea-borne operation serving troubled spots worldwide. Project Hope recently began serving our own needs along the southern border of Texas and Mexico. This region suffers largely because of the nature of rural poverty where healthcare access is complicated by vast distances between care givers and a lack of nutritious food. Project Hope is currently training caregivers and providing resources such as medicine to the region. Much more is being planned to help this dire situation that has been getting worse over the past decade.

WE were all invited to the Project Hope headquarters for their USA kick off event on November 1st 3-5 PM.
