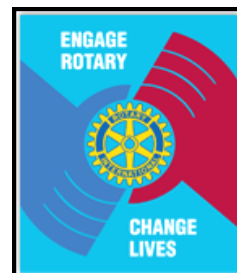

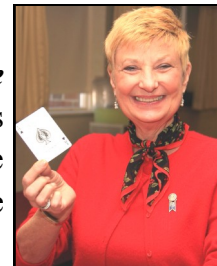

Kaleidoscope:

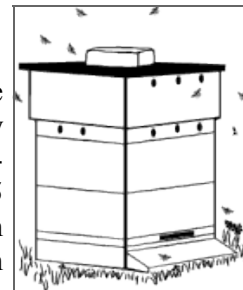
William Aikens announced that the recipient for our 2014 event will be Winchester Medical Center's new Cancer Center.

Foundation Minute

Conrad told us Albania is one of the poorest countries in Europe and Rotary International, working with Heifer International, has provided 125 beehives to 25 poor families. The families are trained in beekeeping so that the hives help sustain the local ecosystem and provide by-products to generate income. At the end of a year, the hives are split, and those 125 new hives are given to 25 more families, thus creating a self-sustaining project producing honey, bees wax and more hives.
