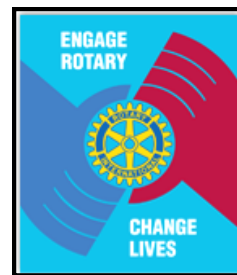
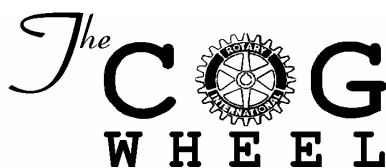

Libba shared the sad news that we have two of our own who could use our thoughts, cards, and prayers. Dick Wiltshire was admitted to intensive care following complications with his pacemaker, while Doc Madagan suffered a stroke requiring hospitalization. Libba will keep us posted, but please keep these two model Rotarians (and good friends) in your thoughts. Stroke survivor Victoria Kidd reminded us that **May is National Stroke Awareness Month**. Nearly 800,000 people have a stroke annually, but up to 80% of them can be prevented by controlling risk factors. Have your physician check your blood pressure, cholesterol, body mass index, and blood sugars regularly.

Foundation Minute

Conrad shared the story of Rotary clubs in Jordan and in the U.S. doing good. Using funds from The Foundation, the clubs teamed up to send a volunteer medical team to Jordan to perform life-saving surgeries that treated 19 children with congenital heart defects. For those families, The Foundation's efforts literally gave the gift of life while *"doing good in the world."*
