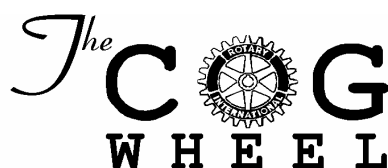
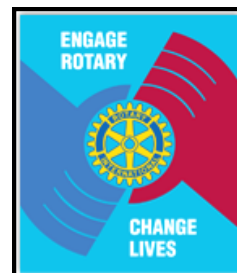

Last Program

Our very own Trish and Harry Ridgeway provided the program for us when last we met at the Travelodge. (Although their period-inspired dress made it hard to believe it was our two familiar Rotarians and not a pair of ghosts from times past.) They presented a fascinating program that detailed the account of Robert Sherrard Bell, Jr.



Bell served in the Virginia Rockbridge Light Artillery (also known as the Stonewall Artillery) from 1861 to 1863. His diary records the account of his participation in the 2nd Battle of Winchester and his first-hand account of Pickett's Charge at Gettysburg. Bell was struck and killed by a large fragment in 1863.

His company respectfully interred his body to a "soldier's grave" before returning the diary and some personal belongings to his family. Relatives Kathy and Tom Bell donated the diary to the Old Court House Civil War Museum in Winchester, Virginia. Historians consider the account to be extremely important. It, along with its transcription, is on display for visitors.

Trish wanted to also ask anyone who has an interest in aiding the museum (either as a volunteer or as a board member) to reach out to her.
