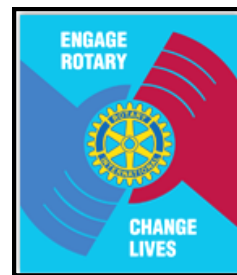
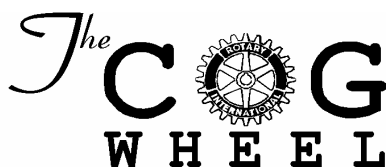

### Our Program Last Week

Winchester Rotarian John Elrick spoke to us about his efforts to start a chapter of Toastmasters International, at Shenandoah University. John joined the local Toastmasters club when he moved to Winchester in 1995. In 2010 he was ready to reach for the highest level of distinction, which is to start a new chapter. His idea was to create a club based at Shenandoah University, which would allow local business people, faculty and students to interact. John did his research and learned that there can be substantial challenges to maintaining a successful Toastmasters chapter at a university.

John is still working on starting this new chapter, and opened the floor to a Winchester Rotary Club brainstorming session to get our input on potential problems and solutions. One question raised was whether Winchester can support a second Toastmasters club. John explained that the current club now has 24 members and it's difficult to get on the speaking schedule. Toastmasters International says a community can support as many Toastmasters clubs as it has McDonald's restaurants.

After a productive discussion, a show of hands indicated at 13 Rotarians would be interested in attending an informational meeting in September. John just needs another 7 attendees, and he's on his way to starting a new chapter.
