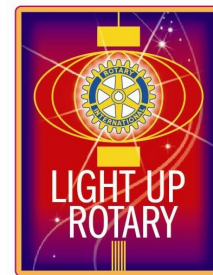

Our Program Last Week - Changing of the Guard

Assistant District Governor, Anita Bryant, announced the president's citation for our Rotary Interact Club at Handley High School. She then congratulated Don Louque on an awesome year full of accomplishments.



Don then shared his parting remarks as President reviewing his goals over the past year. He did have fun although he admits his tenure was not flawless. Tallying his goal to add new members: 18 new members joined but 17 Rotarians departed. Fundraising brought \$100,000 to the Foundation; \$100,000 initiated the Rotary Fund at the Community Foundation of the Northern Shenandoah Valley.

We gave \$48,000 to the R.I. Foundation, thanks in very large part to Conrad's persistence. The website oversight is stronger, as is press coverage of Rotary activities. Finally, Don took credit for the improved lunch cuisine.

Admittedly, serving as a Rotary Chair is a lot of work, but Don attests to the value of this experience vowing that he is a changed man. He encourages others to embrace this rewarding opportunity. Rotarians were encouraged to work together to make a difference in the lives of others. Don closed by thanking fellow officers, the Board and his father who introduced him to Rotary.

Out-going Board Members Trish Stiles, Eric Beatley and Dick Kent were thanked for their past service and incoming members DeeDee Barbour, Sarah Daywalt, Felicia Hart and Conrad Koneczny were welcomed.



Upon being sworn in as our new President, Dan Martin thanked the club for the honor and thanked Don for his leadership and guidance. Dan joined Rotary 9 years ago and now seeks to add more growth to the Foundation, continuing that aspect of the Club's leadership role in the District. Dan also challenged members to establish a new fundraiser and to attract new members to the club. Dan closed by citing the many good deeds supported by Rotary in the local community.
