

Our Program Last Week

Scott Patchan, a board member with Kernstown Battlefield Association and published author gave a very informative presentation on the upcoming 150th anniversary of the Second Battle of Kernstown.





The Kernstown Battlefield As-Kernstown sociation is a non-profit corporation run by a staff made up entirely of volunteers and supported through membership and donations.

July 24th marks the 150th anniversary of the Second Battle of Kernstown. On Saturday, July 19th the association will host a bus tour of the days leading up to the battle as well as the Kernstown Battlefield property itself. Patchan will lead the tour.

He gave us an overview of the narrative of the tour and the importance of the battle in the context of the entire war and the 1864 presidential election. Led by Lt. Gen. Jubal A. Early the Confederate troops routed the Union army at Kernstown inflicting 1,200 casualties upon Maj. Gen. George Crook's forces while only suffering 200 of their own. It has been described as the most easily won battle of the war.

The bus tour will be a wonderful opportunity to experience The Kernstown Battlefield on the Pritchard-Grim Farm as well as many other pristine and seldom seen sites such as Rutherford's Farm and Hupp's Hill.
