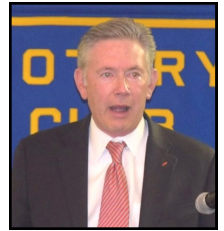
Shrimp Feed

Our Last Program

Ron Kaplan, President and CEO of Trex Corporation is this year's Chairman of the United Way Campaign and spoke to us on the campaign's progress. The United Way is made up of 42 partner agencies all of who benefit from the United Way Campaign. These partner agencies represent 42 touch points for the community which address issues ranging from education to poverty.



Ron spoke of how heartening it was to be surrounded by community leaders all ready to help the United Way Campaign. For this year's campaign, he recruited 17 of the busiest people he knew as he understands busy people get things done. Additionally he recruited his entire area work force of 400 people for pledges which Trex matched. 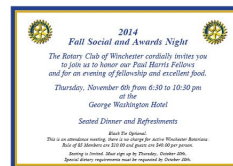
