

# **Our Last Program**

Ron Kaplan. President and CEO of Trex Corporation is this year's Chairman of the United Way Campaign and spoke to us on the campaign's progress. United Way is made up of 42 partner agencies all of who benefit from the



United Way Campaign. These partner agencies represent 42 touch points for the community which address issues ranging from education to poverty.
