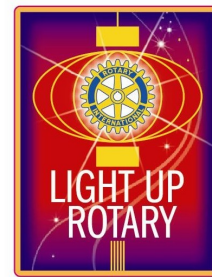
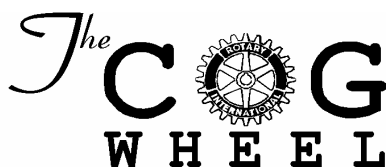

### Our Last Program

Everyone's favorite radio personality Barry Lee, joined us last week to speak about "**Chain of Checks**". Barry has been in the Winchester area for over 32 years and has been with WINC radio for 30 years. 28 years ago Barry went on the radio and asked listeners to send him a Christmas card with \$1 check enclosed to help the needy. They had hoped to collect \$500, but were pleasantly surprised to collect over \$3,000. They hung the cards all around their office and celebrated what they knew would be a WINC/Winchester tradition.



Since those early days the event grew to a point where temporary offices were needed and opened at the Apple Blossom during the drive. **Chain of Checks** schedules two days of "matching" donations which will be December 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> this year. Two years ago **Chain of Checks** trademarked itself and formed a foundation. Since its humble beginnings 28 years ago, **Chain of Checks** has raised and distributed over \$1,000,000 to local charities.
