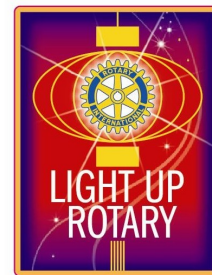

Norman and Amanda Lowe spoke to our club about the Winchester Storm basketball team. The Storm consist of three teams; a semi-pro basketball team, a junior basketball team and a junior dance team.



The semi-pro basketball team had its origins in church basketball but grew to become associated with the Washington Wizards. The relationship is similar to that of a baseball farm team. In this case the Storm is associated with the Washington Wizards and provides a spring board for players wishing to play in the European leagues. Team members travel as far as two hours to play with the team at Handley High School and travel as far away as New York City to play opponents. Players receive no pay.

The junior dance team and basketball team are for kids 7 to 15 years old and is developmental in nature. The kids play and perform at charity events, nursing homes and etc. There are approximately 40 kids involved in total.

**The Rotary Foundation: Doing Good in the World**

One of the six areas of Focus for the Foundation is Maternal and Child Health. Conrad reports that since 2005, there have been 31 Rotary Club Gifts and 18 Foundation Grants totaling almost \$300,000 for projects to support maternal and child health in Nomadic communities in Niger.

An example of one of those projects is a retired doctor from the Rotary Club of Ojai California trained 10 local nomadic women in prenatal and childbirth care. These matrons have attended over 300 births since 2011. They are scheduled to train an additional 20 women next month.
