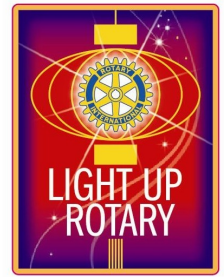
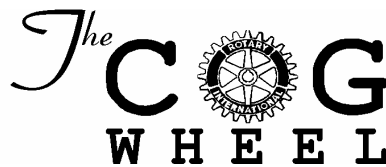

Before the Thanksgiving break, we were visited by retiring Frederick County Administrator, John R. Riley, Jr. Having served in that capacity since 1983, Riley reflected on the many projects he has seen come to fruition in the area, and he provided insight into future challenges that will need to be addressed in order to sustain

the progress we've seen over the past few years.

Riley relayed details about past projects and endeavors of all kinds—including everything from the development of public schools to efforts that would yield fiscally responsible budgets during difficult economic times. While the long list of accomplishments were impressive, he was quick to indicate that the growth we have seen locally is the result of many people working together.

He concluded by saying that work in the public sector is not for everyone. People should recognize that their efforts are for the public good in order to be successful. Furthermore, they should have "an unshakable and authentic passion for this profession."
