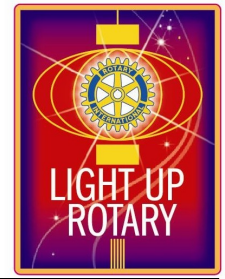
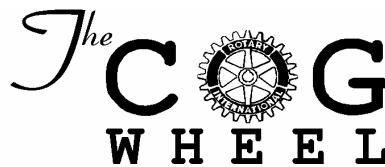

Conrad explained that Section 4 of the Rotary Club Constitution (which is the same throughout the world) designates the week of February 23 as the anniversary of Rotary's founding and World Understanding & Peace week.

The Rotary Club of Winchester contributed just less than \$50,000 to the Foundation in 2014 and we rank #1 in our District for annual fund giving and #2 in polio eradication donations.



### Combined funds raised in 2014 were just under \$80,000. Some of which were:

\$41,136 from Kaleidoscope benefitting the Cancer Center  
 \$13,647 from the Golf Tournament benefitting Special Love  
 \$10,944 from our Rummage Sale benefitting Faith in Action

### 2014 Club Donations included:

\$8,000 to coats for kids (438 coats)  
 \$4,000 to Camp Fantastic (275 meals)  
 \$19,000 to Scholarship Fund (9 students)  
 \$7,500 to Student Loans  
 \$2,625 to Salvation Army Bell ringing from 2 locations  
 + Christmas Gifts for the 11 Evans Home Children

ALSO, with a matching grant from the District and \$2,000 from Christ Church, \$8,000 was gifted to the Backpack Program benefitting 54 children for their weekend meals. AND, one student was hosted for the Youth Exchange (Hunter Knox is in Peru) and the Nybergs are hosting a student from Denmark.
