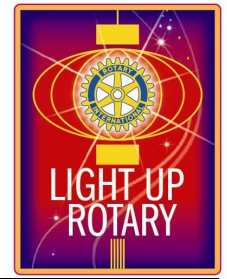
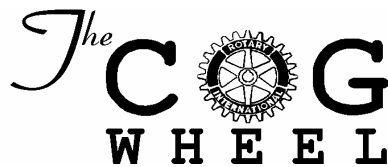

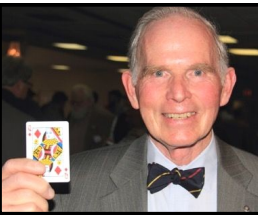


Rotary Foundation Minute (or so)
