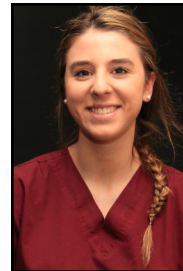
Our Last Program

The club met two members of the Rotary International exchange program.



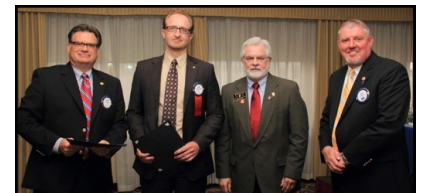

Conrad's foundation minute focused on disease prevention and treatment. A Physiatrist is a physician who treats injuries or illnesses that affect movement. With a Rotary Foundation grant, a vocational team, which also included a physical therapist, an occupational therapist and a speech therapist, traveled from Atlanta to Ecuador. The grant provided 145 wheelchairs for indigent patients in a local hospital in Guayaquil. The team led educational programs in therapeutic techniques, chronic pain management and wheelchair operation and safety.

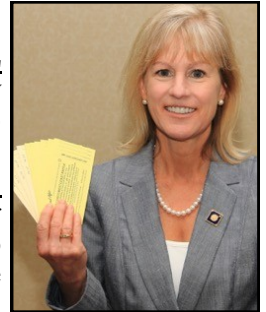
Libba's Health Report:
