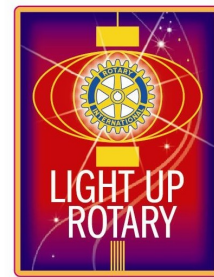
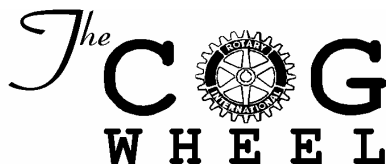

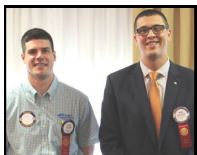

Our Program Last Week



Retiring Assistant District Governor, Aneita Bryant, on behalf of the Trustees of the Rotary Foundation expressed appreciation for their support of its humanitarian and educational mission to Hunter and Shirley Gaunt for their generous donation.



Aneita touted the importance of Area 1's giving and receiving. In her story of the eyeglasses, she described how Rotarians are trusted couriers that show kindness and charity. Citing the many philanthropic fundraising activities engendered by The Rotary Club of Winchester (Rummage Sale, Exchange Student, Coats for Kids, Habitat for Humanity, international projects) she credited Rotarians for their service and willingness to work together.



New Assistant District Governor, George Karnes welcomed Tootie Rinker as incoming President with a "goofy" tee shirt and words of encouragement. In the year ahead, Tootie intends to reshape the Apple Harvest Festival and dedicate 2 meetings a year that focus on the infrastructure of the club. Tootie thanked retiring President, Dan Martin, for his accomplishments and for living the 4-way test. She presented him with the gavel plaque and invited him to join the traditional line of past presidents in passing the gavel.

Dan Martin thanked the club for the opportunity and the honor to serve. His accomplishments fueled the desire to do more. During his presidency, the Rotary Club of Winchester raised over \$95,000, of which \$81,000 was distributed locally. In addition, water projects in Bangladesh and in Ghana were funded as were meals for families in need.
