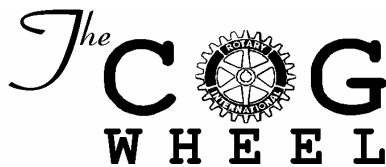
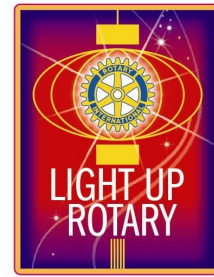

Thank you to Dan Martin and his crew for another great Family Picnic!! The weather was perfect and the food was outstanding.

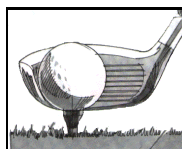

Our Last Program

Our very own Darla shared exciting news about the reinvented Apple Harvest Festival. For starters, the festival will now be known as The Shenandoah Valley Apple Harvest Festival. This reflects the nature of the festival. It's an event to be celebrated far and wide.



Its relocation allows us to now offer unlimited outdoor space for vendors and exhibitors as well as indoor space, but more interesting than that is that the change of venue means we can set up a separate, ticketed area for hard ciders, craft beers, and wine tasting! 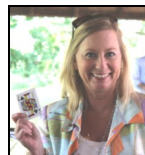
