


## **DISTRICT GOVERNOR'S VISIT**

## Our Last Program

Our speaker was Dr. Barry Thompson, a physician-geneticist who served as Medical Director for the American College of Medical Genetics and Genomics, in Bethesda, MD. His previous 30 year career in the US Air Force, in-




cluded three years as head of the Center for Medical and Molecular Genetics at the Armed Forces Institute of Pathology in Washington.

Dr. Thompson gave us an overview of advances in the understanding of human genetics from 6000 years ago to present. Our increasing knowledge about the human genome provides opportunities to improve life, and raises ethical questions. For example, the gene that causes sickle cell anemia also protects against malaria. Providing patients with information indicating they are likely to develop Huntington's disease or breast cancer presents them with a new set of problems and potentially life altering decisions.

A few decades ago, genetic researchers thought that 100,000 genes controlled 100,000 traits. It is now believed that 20,000 or even 10,000 genes can affect 100,000 traits. This means that for every predictable outcome of a genetic choice, there could also be five or ten times that number of unintended consequences.

So, where does that leave the theory "It's in the genes"???
