### Our Last Program

Josh Phelps, President of Winchester Metals, spoke to us about the annual **Widget Cup Competition**, which was held for the first time last spring and is coming up on April 9th next year. Eight student representatives from each of our four area high schools compete on a project, the instructions for which are provided at the start of the competition. Working as a team, they must design, build, and present the project in a single day. The purpose of the event is to give them a taste of what working in textiles is like in the real world.



Josh, who spent 10 years on the Economic Development Commission, came up with the idea for the competition as a way to foster interest in metal-working, wood-working, and other vocational trades. As he said, "You gotta have a **Plan B** because a lot of students don't finish college." Working with Steve Straight, the Supervisor of Career and Technical Education for Frederick Co. Schools, they put together the event with donations from many of our local building industry leaders, including Winchester Metal Works, Frogale Lumber, and Trex.
