The distinction of Paul Harris Fellow was also given to a few non-members: Brona Tyson (given by John Tyson), Tina Williams (given by Michael Williams), and Lauren Cummings (presented from the club by Don Butler for her work as Executive Director of the Substance Abuse Coalition).

THE CLIFF DOCHTERMAN AWARD, which recognizes an individual who acts as a role model and renders distinguished and dedicated service to Scouting, was given to Michael Williams.

THE DISTINGUISHED SERVICE AWARD honorees were Scott Arthur (+4) and Kerri Burkhart (+1). This award is given for exceptional continuous service to our club. Our previously designated DSA honorees who were awarded Mulitiple Paul Harris Fellow recognition were Jeff Davis and Dan Martin. Both of these honorees are major donors and \$1,000 was given in their name to Rotary International in recognition of this award.

OUR LAST PROGRAM

Sara Schoonover-Martin from the **Healthy Families** initiative of the Northern Shenandoah Valley spoke to the club about the community need for this program and its growth over the past 19 years.

Marjorie Lewis one of the program's founding members introduced Sara and

thanked our club for its fundraising efforts in 1998 to help launch the initiative. She also urged our members to contact their legislators to encourage them to pass legislation for continued funding of the program.

The program's mission is to provide education and support for all families to promote healthy births and continued nurturing to ensure children can reach school age emotionally and physically healthy.

Sara described the initiative as a community collaborative process that provides education and support to families from the 20th week of pregnancy until the child is five years old. She talked about the importance of the first 1,000 days of a child's life and how crucial it is for brain development. She explained that toxic exposure to stress during that time can have an impact throughout a lifetime. She described a measurement called Adverse Childhood Experiences that can help determine adult behavior.

Sara described many of the benefits of the program not just to the individual family but the community at-large. It is a voluntary program and potential families are screened at Winchester Medical Center. The program continues to grow. In 1999 they served 43 families and in 2016 they served 171 families.

Sara ended her program by showing a moving five minute film that summed up the program by stating that if you change the first five years you change everything.
