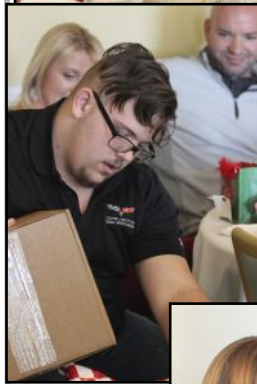
LAST MEETING - OUR CHRISTMAS PROGRAM
