LAST PROGRAM

Dianne Klopp, the founder and President of **Honor Flight, Top of Virginia Chapter**, spoke about her organizations service to veterans. Honor Flight was founded by Earl Morse, a Physician's Assistant and Air Force veteran from Springfield, OH, who discovered in 2004 that patients at the VA hospital in which he worked couldn't afford (or weren't able) to visit the new World War II memorial in Washington, DC.



Earl personally flew a WWII vet to see the WWII memorial and, the following year, asked fellow pilots in his flying club if they would join him. Many did. From those humble beginnings was born an organization that to date has allowed more than 180,000 veterans to see memorials in DC. Honor flight operates out of 131 cities in 45 states and there is currently a waiting list of more than 27,000 veterans hoping to participate. Southwest Airlines has become a major national partner.

Dianne says the Top of Virginia Chapter does not currently have a waiting list (most likely due to the fact that they were founded less than two years ago), so their main focus is on getting the word out to local veterans. According to national reports, 340 WWII veterans die every day, so time is running out to provide them with this deserved honor. **Cold Weather Health Tip**
