**OUR LAST PROGRAM**

**Leslie Caliva** is the Executive Director of the **American Red Cross Central** which includes Shenandoah Valley gave us an update on the organization. Leslie began her Red Cross career as a volunteer in Europe 37 years ago and has only grown more passionate about the Red Cross since her beginnings. The Red Cross moto is to "prevent and alleviate Suffering" and they accomplish this goal in concert with it's more than 200 affiliates. It is the largest and most welcomed relief organization in the world. We commonly think of them for their blood drives but they are present virtually any time there is a natural disaster, refugee needs or even if a person's house burns down. They are not government affiliated so there is no government budget. Their budget is derived entirely from donations. Locally the Red Cross has had numerous disasters to contend with recently including flooding in Charlottesville, tornadoes in Lynchburg and a rash of house fires. In each and every case the Red Cross is expected and is there to help. They provide temporary shelter, food and emergency medical help. All of these disasters are things we can help with as volunteers and donors. Our area Red Cross maintains a relationship with over 900 volunteers who agree to help at a moment's notice. Imagine if this help were not available when needed!
